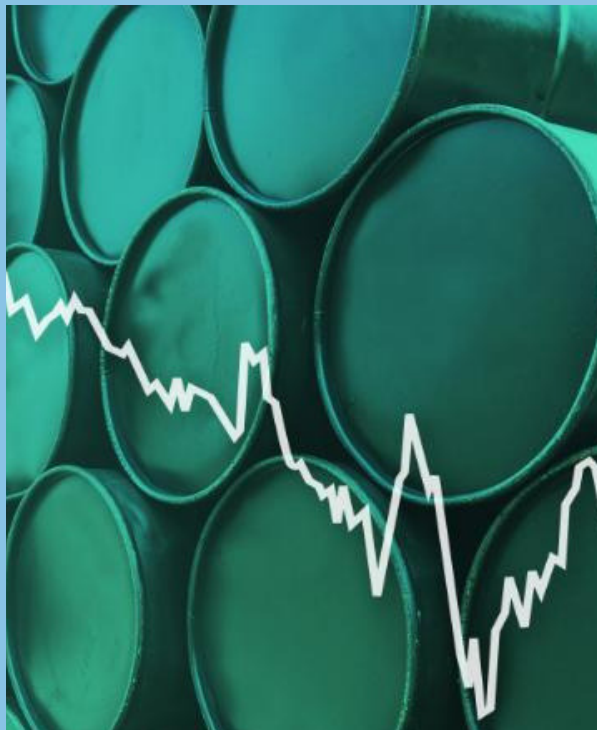

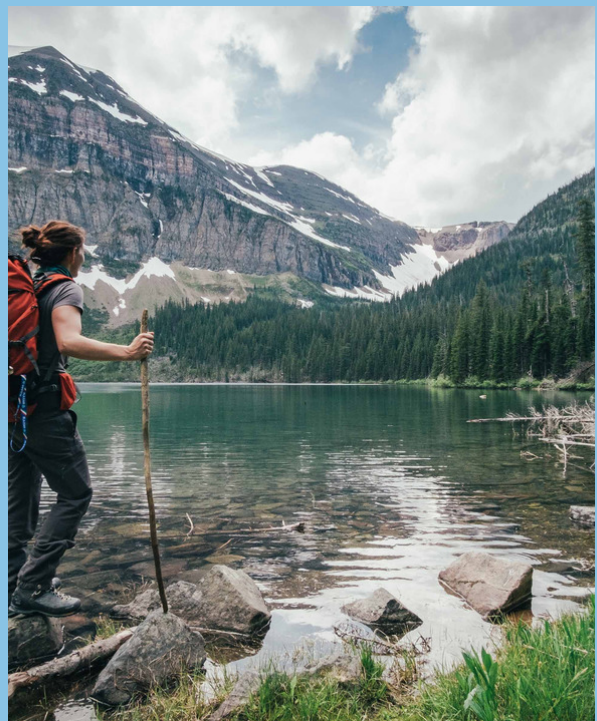

The Exceptional Price Performance of Oil - Explanations & Prospects

\$45 SPE Members, \$55 Non-Members, \$15 Students

Oil price developments over the past 45 years have been truly spectacular. In constant money, prices rose by 759% between 1970-72 and 2012-14. This can be compared with a price index for metals and minerals, which increased by a mere 38%. The analysis shows that the exceptionality of oil's upward price push over the past decades cannot be adequately explained by cost-raising depletion or by OPEC interventions.
